

## **QS SUMMIT: AWARDING OF DULATY UNIVERSITY WITH QS STARS RATING**

The QS Higher Education Summit: Asia Pacific is being held in Macau from November 5–7, 2024, coinciding with the 20th anniversary of the QS World University Rankings. The summit brings together over 2000 participants, including influential figures from higher education, business leaders, government officials involved in higher education policy, university rectors and representatives from the Asia-Pacific region, as well as researchers and academics.

On the first day of the summit, the QS Stars University Awards Ceremony took place, recognizing universities from around the world. The QS World University Rankings agency rigorously evaluates universities across key areas, such as teaching, facilities, sustainability, research, and employability.

The goal of this ranking is to provide prospective students with a comprehensive understanding of the strengths of various universities, covering everything from research and employment outcomes to social responsibility and inclusivity.
