

DULATY UNIVERSITY AWARDED REPORTER STATUS IN THE 2024 TIMES HIGHER EDUCATION ASIA UNIVERSITY RANKINGS

On April 30, 2024, the Times Higher Education (THE) Asia University Rankings were published. The ranking included 739 Asian universities (compared to 669 last year) from 31 countries and regions. A total of 18 indicators were evaluated, covering teaching, research, knowledge transfer, and international outlook.

The number of higher education institutions included in THE rankings has been increasing year by year. This ranking, which many well-known universities strive to participate in, has become a highly exclusive benchmark. This year marks the 12th edition of the THE Asia University Rankings. It is only the second time that the methodology has undergone significant updates since the launch of the World University Rankings 20 years ago, and according to THE, it now better reflects the evolving nature of higher education in Asia.

Dulaty University submitted its data to participate in this important ranking, and our university has been awarded «reporter» status based on the evaluation of 18 criteria. This status indicates that our university is an active participant in the ranking process.

According to THE requirements, for full participation in the global ranking, universities must have at least 1000 publications indexed in Scopus over the past five years, and this level must be maintained.

Currently, Dulaty University has 463 Scopus-indexed publications over the last five years. To strengthen the academic and research capacity of the university, a new Development Program has been designed through 2029, which includes both qualitative and quantitative indicators, a new KPI system for all levels of management, faculty, and research staff. This initiative will also help improve the scientometric performance of the entire university.
