

DULATY UNIVERSITY HAS BEEN GRANTED "REPORTER" STATUS IN THE TIMES HIGHER EDUCATION ASIA RANKINGS 2026

On April 24, 2026, the international rating agency Times Higher Education (THE) officially notified Dulaty University of its assignment of «Reporter» status based on its participation in the 2026 Asia University Rankings.

This status indicates that the university has submitted data to the international ranking system and has taken part in the evaluation process.

A total of 929 universities from 36 countries participated in the THE Asia University Rankings 2026, which are based on 18 performance indicators across key areas such as research, teaching, education quality, and internationalization.

The «Reporter» status represents one of the university's most significant achievements in terms of transparency, engagement with international data, and integration into the global academic landscape. This status is considered an entry-level stage, enabling the university to monitor its development and fully participate in the rankings in the future.
